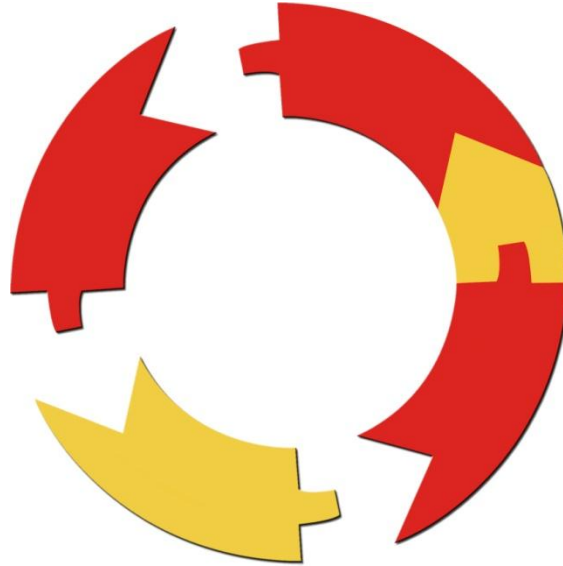

2014 Annual Survey-Updated June 2014



Survey Overview

- 2014 Avondale Community Survey administered in March 2014
- All adults on the lease over 18 were eligible to complete the survey
- 401 survey responses collected (includes dependents), currently 449 residents live in the 5 buildings supported by HUD Choice Implementation Grant funds
- 2014 annual survey asked questions on the community, individual resident employment, health and wellness, early childhood, and safety

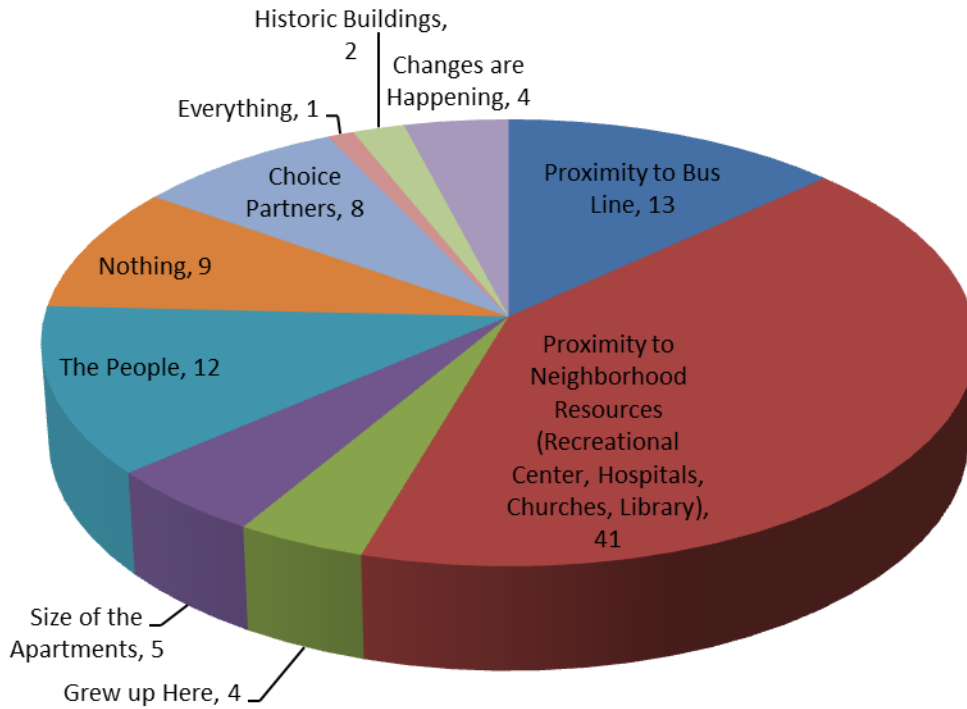

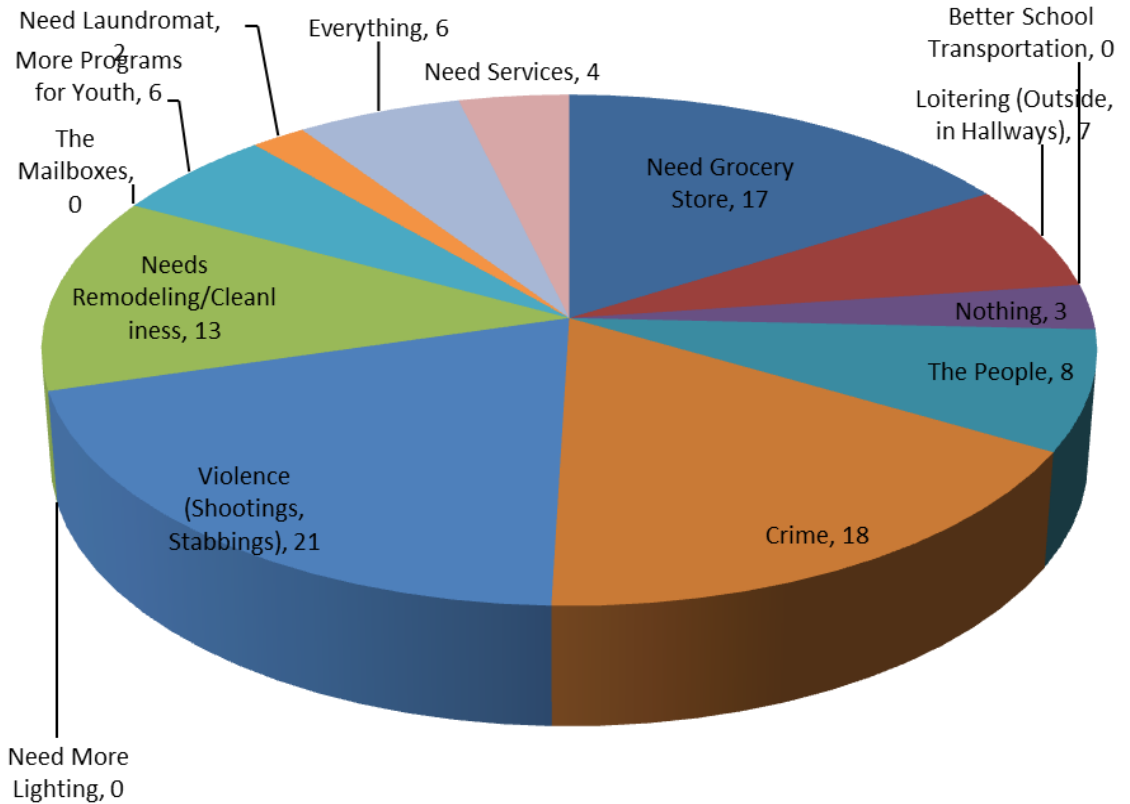

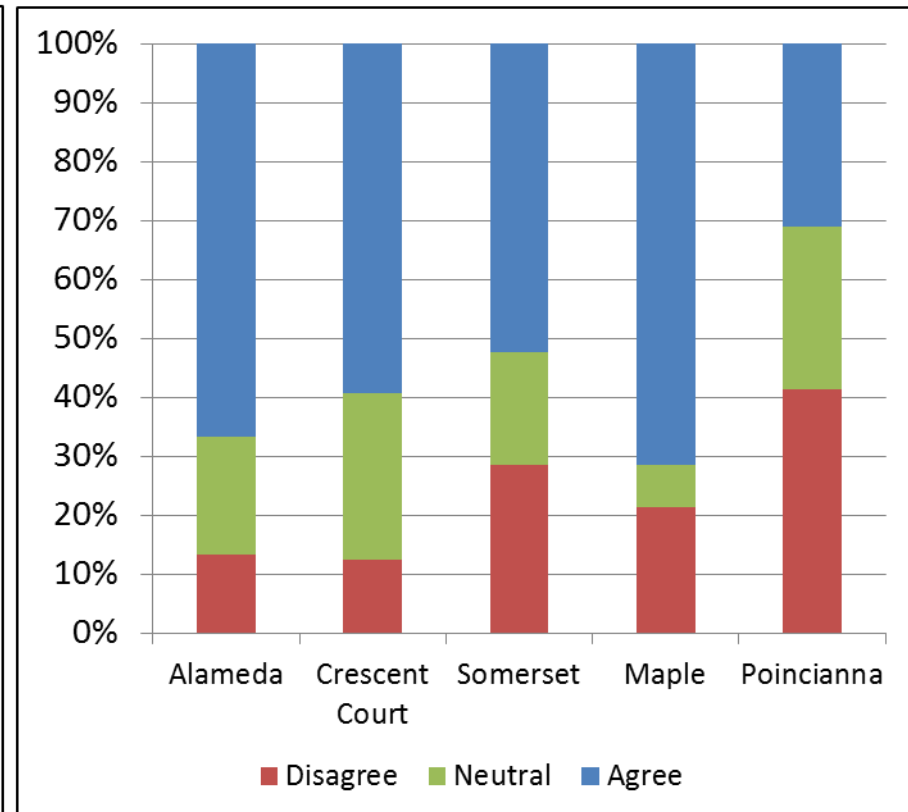

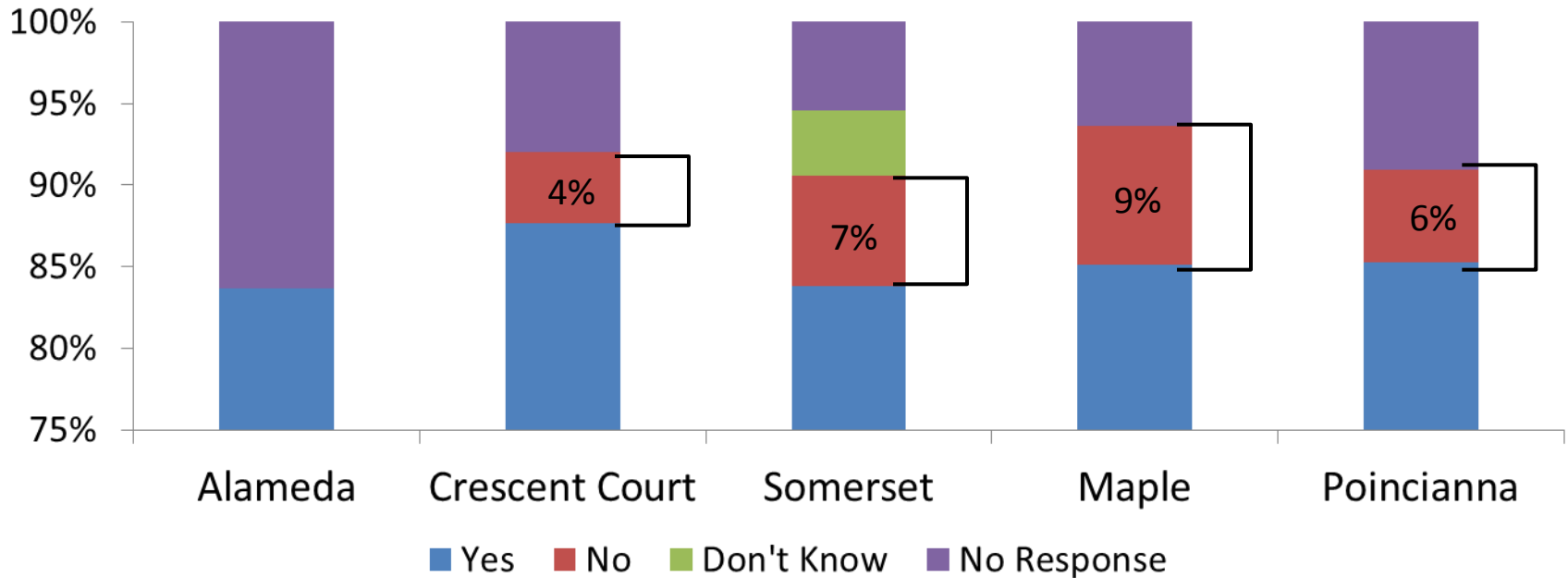

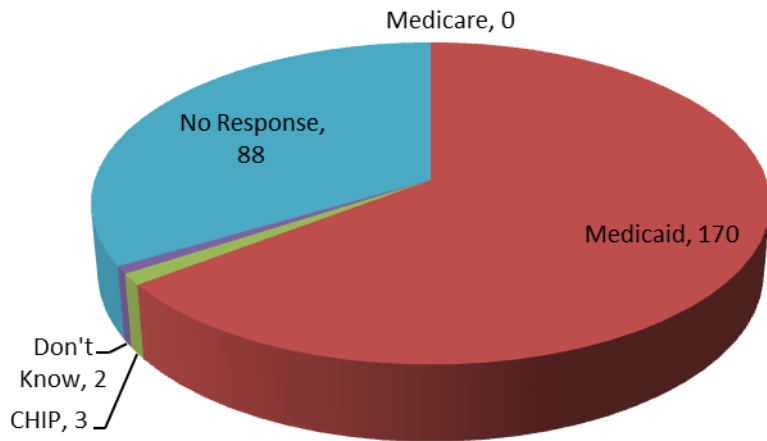


Medicare and Medicaid Coverage

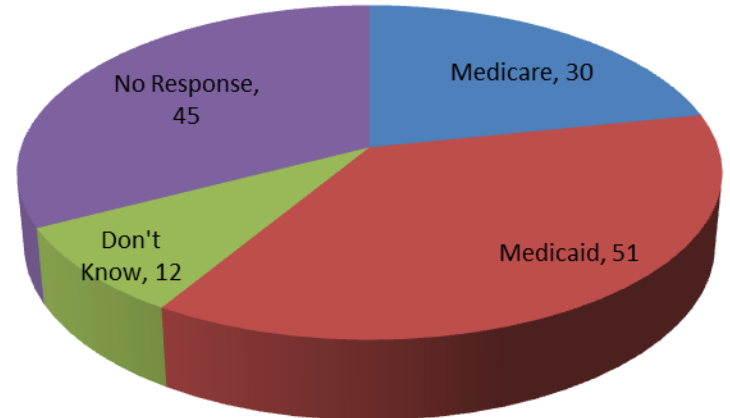

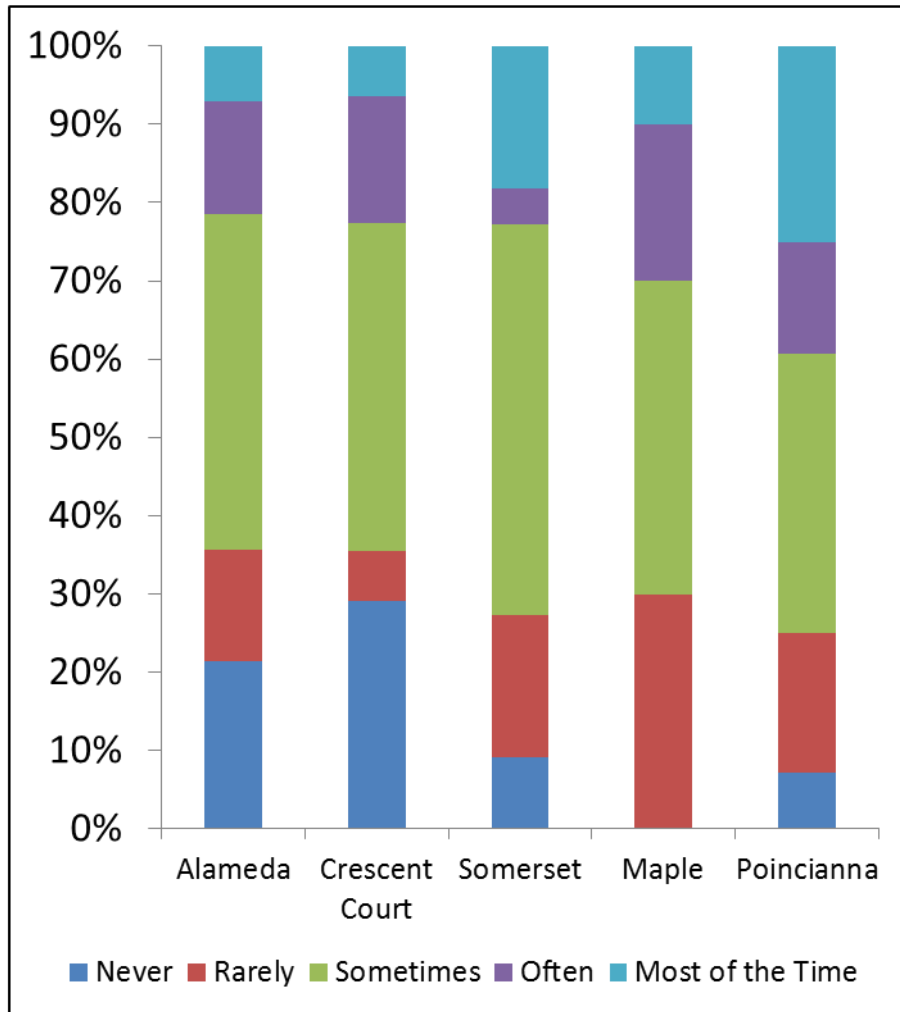
Resident Self-Report Health Rating

- Residents were asked to rate their general health
 - *Alameda*: 63% in excellent or good health, 4% in fair or poor health, 33% no response
 - *Crescent Court*: 78% in excellent or good health, 10% in fair or poor health, 12% no response
 - *Somerset*: 70% in excellent or good health, 9% in fair or poor health, 20% no response
 - *Maple*: 85% in excellent or good health, 2% in fair or poor health, 13% no response
 - *Poincianna*: 72% in excellent or good health, 20% in fair or poor health, 8% no response



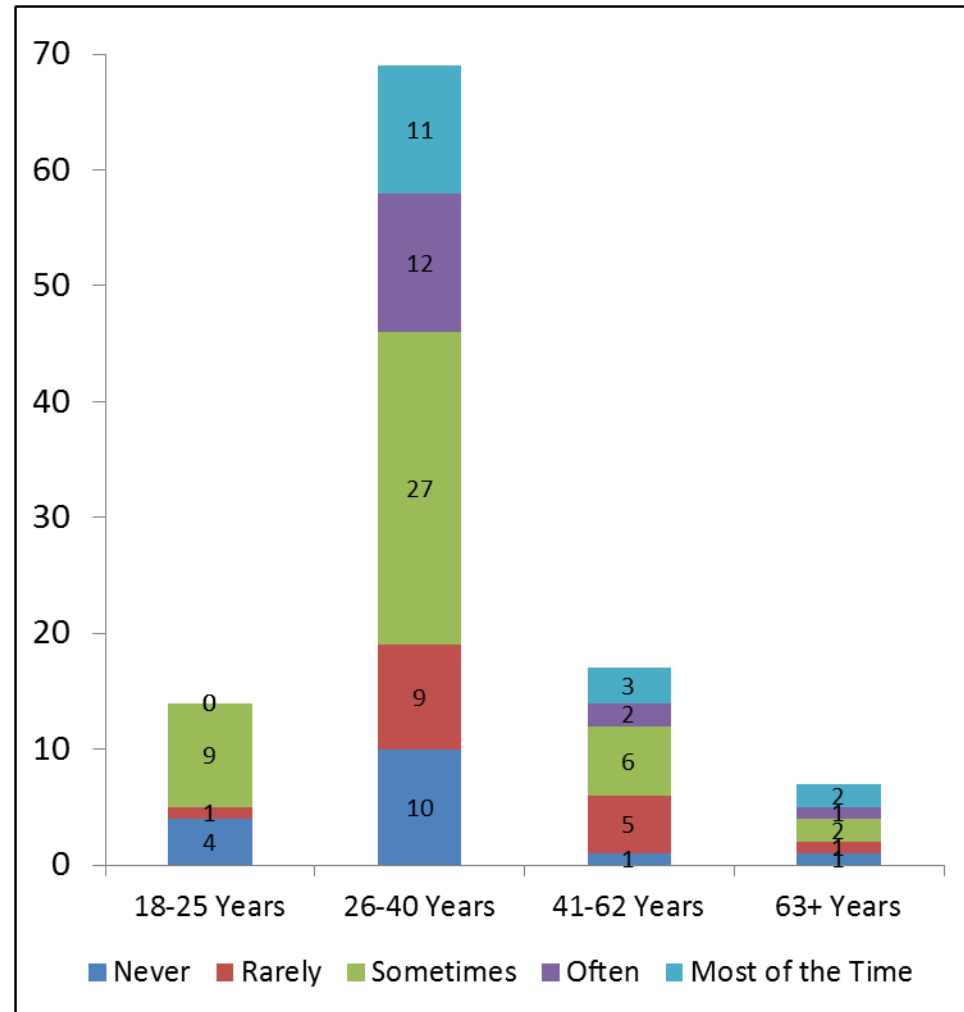
Resident Stress

Resident Stress by Age Group

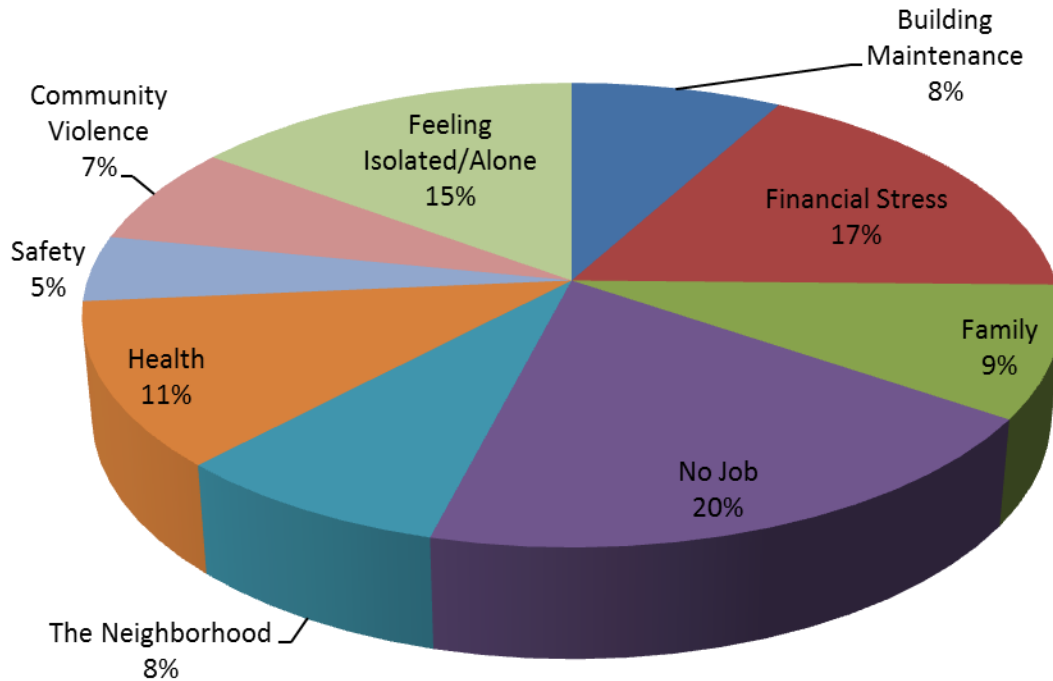

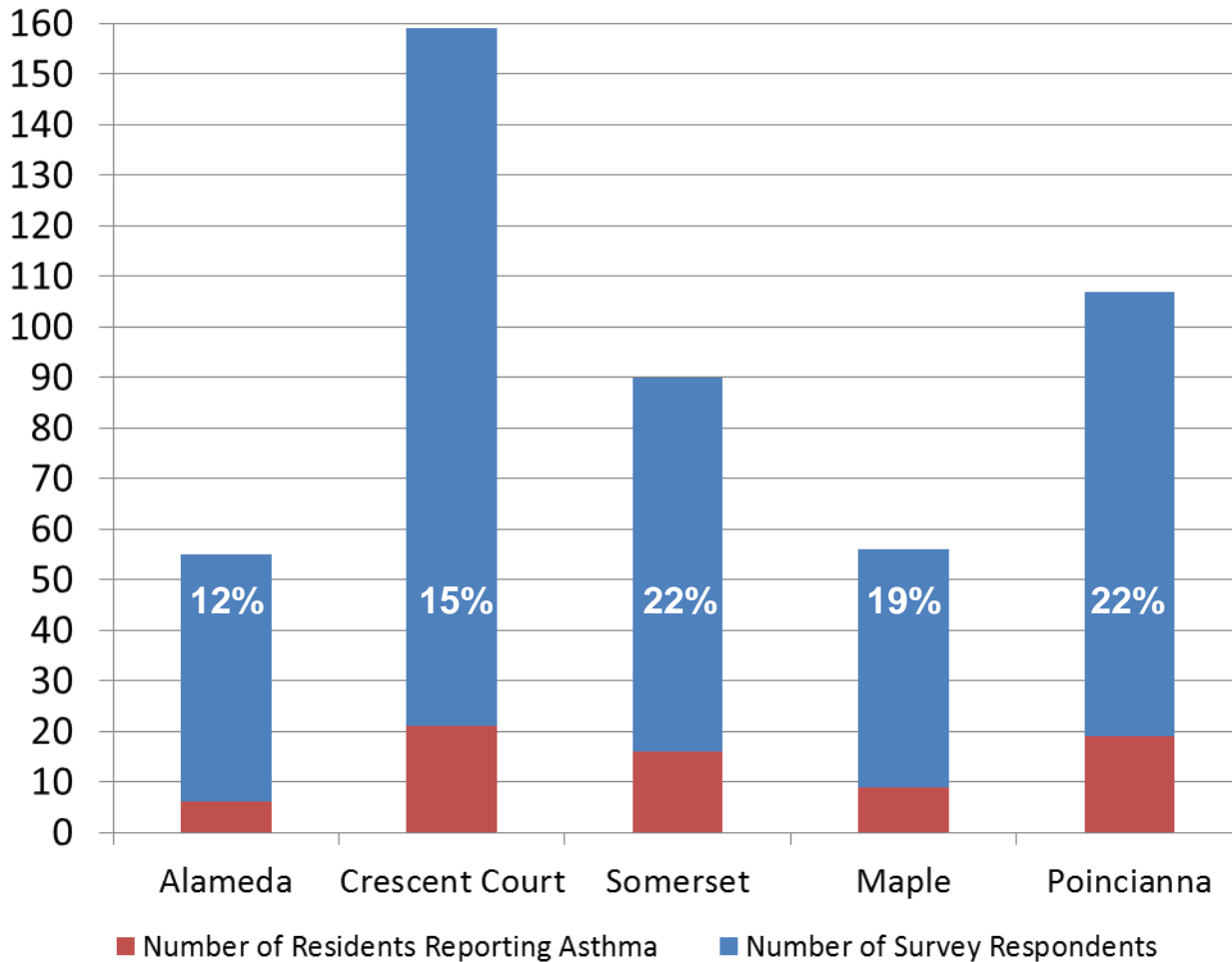

Asthma Rates by Choice Building



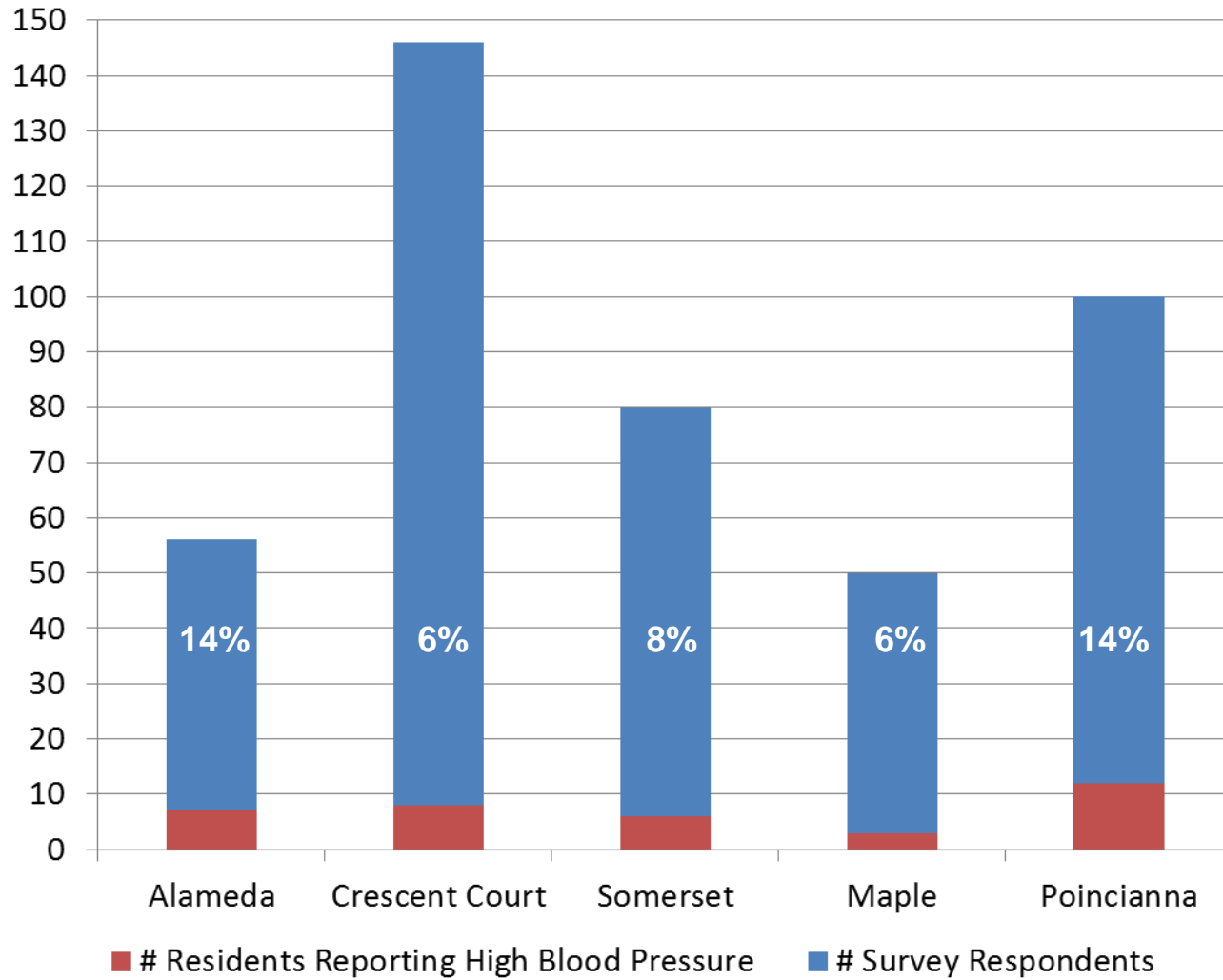

High Blood Pressure by Choice Building



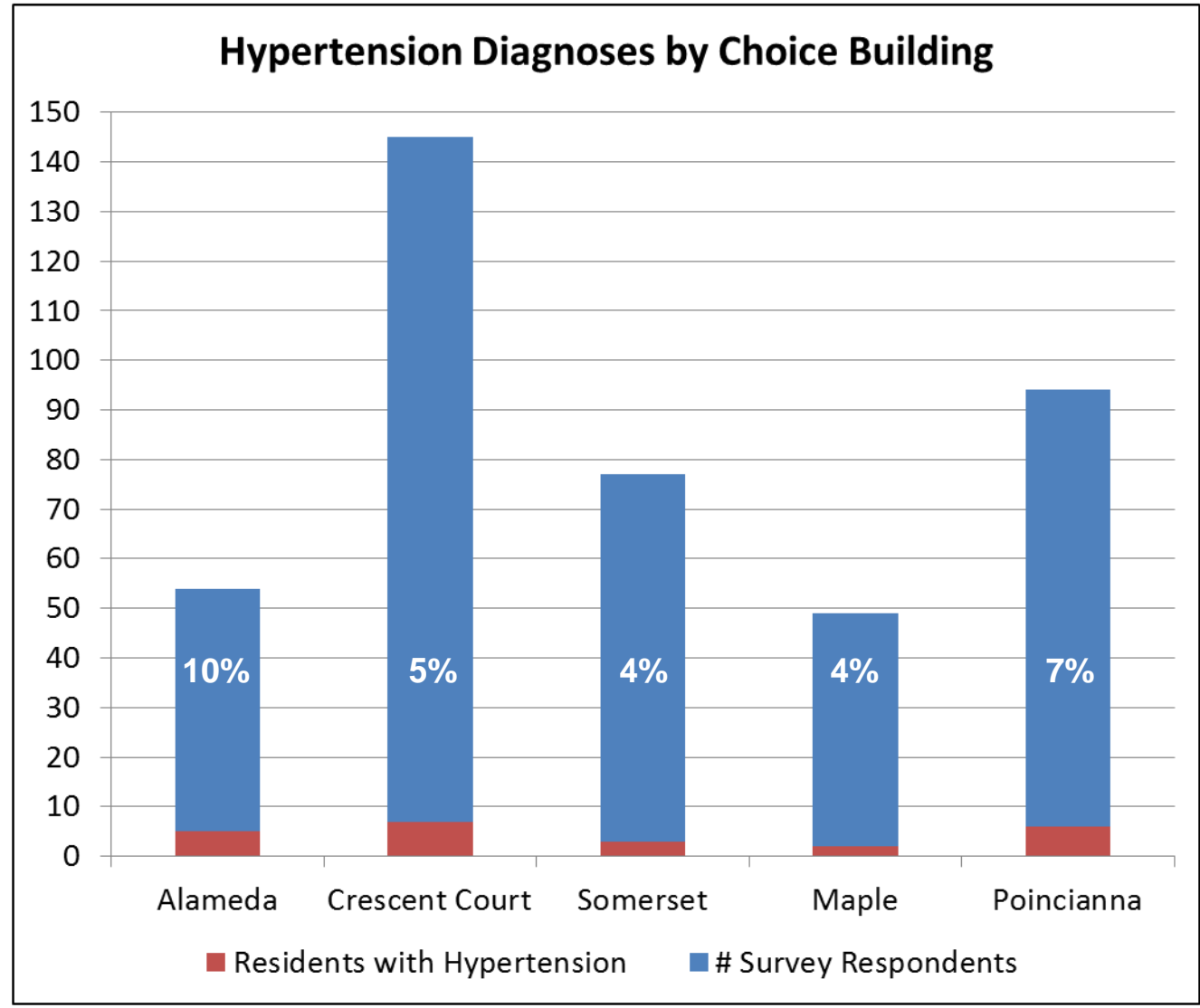

Hypertension Diagnoses

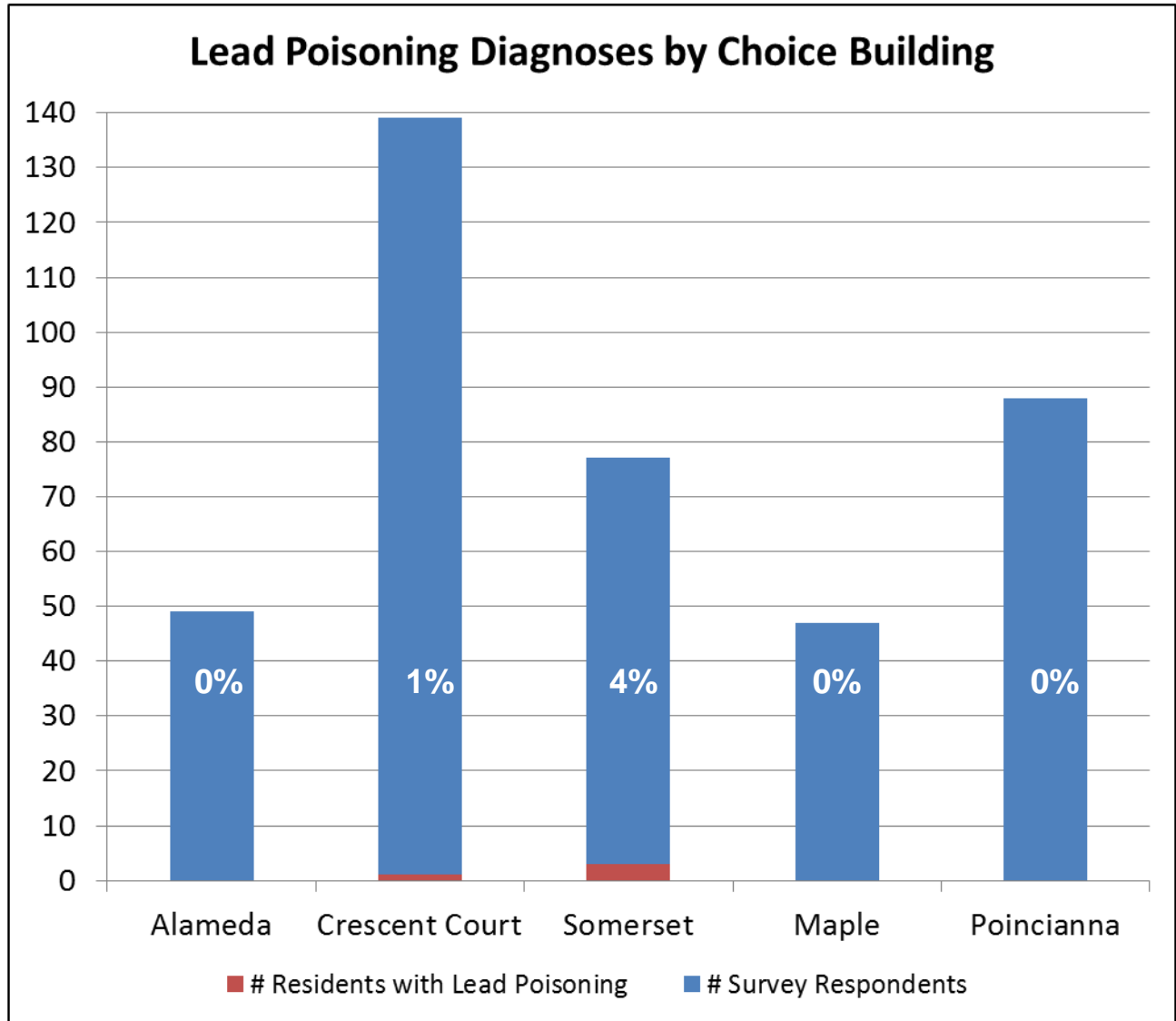

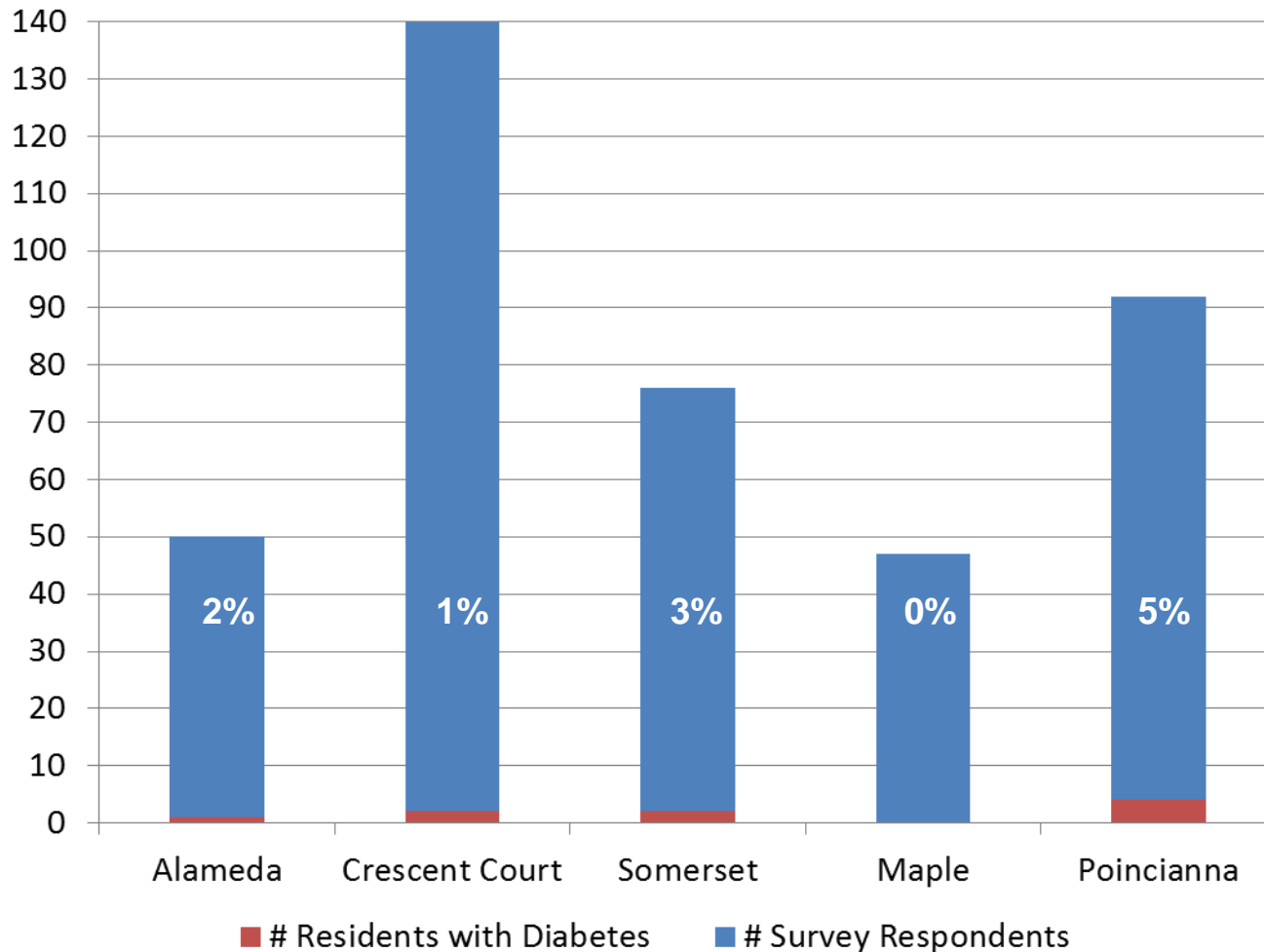

YOUTH EDUCATION CINCINNATI PUBLIC SCHOOLS



Data Sharing with Cincinnati Public Schools

- 297 children ages 0-17
- Parents signed consent forms for data sharing with CPS for 266 youth in the 5 Choice buildings
- Of those 266, 196 have a CPS ID in the system
- 125 residents have a CPS ID and school information for that child

CPS ID numbers stay with the student for life. If a student enrolled at any point, they have an ID even if they are not currently attending a Cincinnati Public School

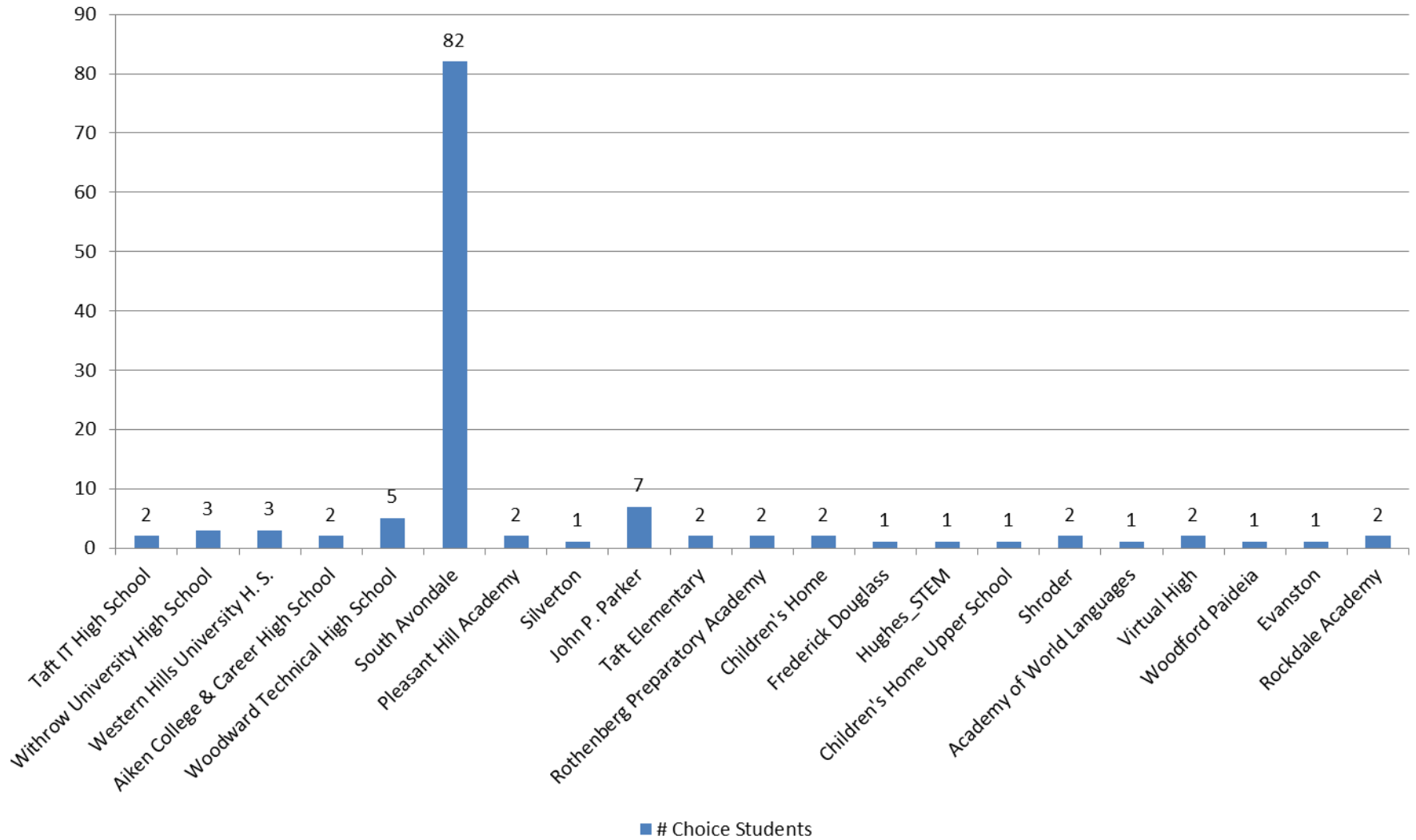


Ohio Standardized Testing for Choice Report

- KRA-L: Kindergarten test taken in September each year
 - *Changing 2015 school year*
- OAA: State test taken by 3rd-8th graders
 - *Changing 2015 school year*
- OGT: taken in high school
- Choice residents attend 21 CPS schools (elementary to high school)

76% of Choice residents attending South Avondale Elementary are proficient and above in Math and Reading



Kindergarten Readiness KRA-L

- 15 Choice residents assessed in 2013 school year
- 3 residents were assessed broadly for intense instruction, 7 were assessed for targeted instruction, 5 were assessed for enriched instruction
- Choice baseline is for enriched instruction (33% of Kindergarteners tested)

Score Band	Recommended Action
0-13	Assess broadly for intense instruction
14-23	Assess for targeted instruction
24-29	Assess for enriched instruction

WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT



Choice Building Employment Rate

- Residents between ages 18 and 64: 144
- Of those 144, 22 receive SSI/disability benefits
- 29 residents currently have wages making the employment rate 23.7%
- Average earned income is \$11,951 per year
 - In the community survey, 35 residents indicated they are interested in being contacted about employment opportunities
 - 16 residents responded that they are not interested
